## About the Artists



Making her mark as an "especially impressive" (The New York Times) soprano, Australian/American **Nola Richardson** has won First Prize in all three major American competitions focused on the music of J.S. Bach (Bethlehem Bach, 2016; Audrey Rooney Bach, 2018; Grand Rapids Symphony Linn Maxwell Keller Award, 2019). These honors have catapulted her to the forefront of Baroque ensembles and orchestras around the country, where she has been praised for her "astonishing balance and accuracy," "crystalline diction," and "natural-sounding ease" (Washington Post).

In concert, Nola's repertoire ranges from medieval to contemporary works – including several world premieres — and she has been particularly noted for her interpretations of Bach, Handel, and Mozart. Recent seasons have featured her debuts with the Pittsburgh, Seattle, Kansas City, Helena, and Colorado Symphonies in performances of Handel's *Messiah* in which she was described as "agile and crystalline-voiced...a stand-out" (Seattle Times). *Messiah* was also the vehicle for her acclaimed Carnegie Hall debut with *Musica Sacra* under conductor Kent Tritle. She has performed Mozart's *Exultate Jubilate* with Grand Rapids Symphony, a *Sondheim* review with the Boston Pops, Haydn's *Creation* with the Akron Symphony, Bach's *St. Matthew Passion* with Portland Symphony and *Musica Angelica* and numerous works of Bach with the Baltimore Symphony and the American Classical Orchestra among others. Her debut in Bach's *Coffee Cantata* with *Philharmonia Baroque* was noted for her "graceful ebullience" (San Francisco Chronicle) and performances in Handel's *La Resurrezione* and a program of French Baroque music with the American Bach Soloists drew praise for her "lusciously polished...exemplary impassioned singing" (San Francisco Classical Voice).

Past operatic highlights include Nola's debut at the Kennedy Center with *Opera Lafayette* (Fraarte in Handel *Radamisto*) which drew praise for her "particularly appealing freshness and directness" (Washington Post), and a "standout" performance (*Opera News*) as the First Lady in *Die Zauberflöte* with the Clarion Music Society. Recently she has interpreted the role of Apolo in a rare performance of the Baroque *Zarzuela Apolo e Dafne* by Sebastián Durón. She made her debut with the Boston Early Music Festival in the summer of 2023 performing in Desmarest's *Circé* and as Oreste Nunzia in Francesca Caccini's *Alcina*.

During the Covid-19 pandemic, Richardson took part in a wide variety of virtual projects including appearances with the Atlanta Symphony in a documentary, "In the Key of Bach" led by Robert Spano, solo concerts with *Musica Angelica* and the Colorado Bach Ensemble, and programs with the National Cathedral, the Bach Choir of Bethlehem, *Seraphic Fire*, and *Voices of Ascension*. In addition to these video productions, her discography includes recent recordings with the Cantata Collective (Bach *St. John Passion*), the Baltimore Choral Arts (*Mozart Requiem*), the Boston Early Music Festival (*Desmarest Circé*), and the Clarion Choir (*Rachamaninoff Liturgy of St. John Chrysostom*).

In addition to her work in the concert, opera, and early music realms, Nola is also a devoted chamber musician and has performed, toured, and recorded with Grammy nominated ensembles *Seraphic Fire*, *Clarion*, *Musica Sacra*, and *Trinity Wall Street*. Recently, she has appeared as the soprano soloist for world premieres of choral works by Garth Neustadter, Frank La Rocca, and Wayne Oquin and taken

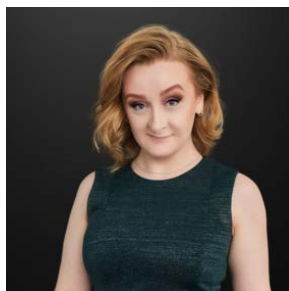
part in additional premieres by David Lang, Hannah Lash, and David Briggs. She was a soloist in the debut performance of Michael Gandolfi's *Carroll in Numberland* alongside soprano Dawn Upshaw at Tanglewood, and the dedicatee of Katherine Balch's *these intervals matter*.

Nola is the first and only soprano to receive the prestigious DMA degree in Early Music Voice from Yale. Her upcoming season will include performances of *Messiah* at St. Thomas Church in NYC and with the St. Paul Chamber Orchestra and Pacific Symphony; *Mozart Exsultate Jubilate* with Voices of Music; *Bach B Minor Mass* at Alice Tully Hall with the American Classical Orchestra; a return to Carnegie Hall with *Musica Sacra in Handel Samson*; and return appearances with *Bach in Bethlehem*; the *Aspect Chamber Series*; *Seraphic Fire*; *Ars Lyrica Houston*; and the *Cantata Collective*.

An Australian by birth, Nola has spent most of her life in the US. She holds a BM from Illinois Wesleyan University and dual MM degrees in Vocal Performance and Early Music from the Peabody Conservatory. She was a young artist with the Boston Early Music Festival, a vocal fellow at Tanglewood, a Marc and Eva Stern Fellow at Songfest, and most recently, a Carmel Bach Festival Virginia Best Adams Fellow in 2019. Nola attended the Institute of Sacred Music Program and in May of 2020 she was the first and only female singer to receive the prestigious DMA degree in Early Music Voice from Yale.



From ballads to Bach, storytelling is the centerpiece of Baltimore based soprano/multi-instrumentalist **Mara Yaffee's** interpretations. As a songwriter and singer of traditional folk music of the English language, Mara uses guitar, autoharp, mountain dulcimer, and other instruments to accompany herself. Mara has recently appeared onstage with companies including *IN Series Opera* in DC and *The Boston Early Music Festival*. Mara holds degrees from *Carnegie Mellon University* and *Peabody Conservatory*.



Mezzo-soprano **Patricia Hengen** is a Baltimore native, who has performed in numerous venues in the Mid-Atlantic region. She was seen in Annapolis Opera's productions of *L'elisir d'amore*, and *Die Zauberflöte* as the *Dreite Knabe*. In 2023, she represented the North Carolina region in the Metropolitan Opera's *Laffont Competition*. Recent roles include *Aunt Dee/Drosselmeyer* (*The Nutcracker*), *Florinda* (*Into the Woods*), *Annina* (*La Traviata*), and *Le Prince Charmant* (*Cendrillon*). Other productions include *La Bohème*, *Carmen*, *Madama Butterfly*, *South Pacific*, *Hairspray: In Concert*. She has appeared as a soloist with *Baltimore Choral Arts Society*, the *Baltimore Symphony*, and the *City Choir of Washington* under the direction of Grammy award-winning conductor, *Robert Shafer*. Ms. Hengen is a member of the *Voice Faculty* at *Morgan State University* and the *Baltimore School for the Arts*. Ms. Hengen is a graduate of *Shenandoah Conservatory*.





**Cameron Falby** (tenor) is an artist and vocalist based in Baltimore. Raised by two choir directors in central Maryland, they went on to study at Manhattan School of Music and then the Peabody Conservatory, where they received a BM in Composition. They work as a freelance choral singer and vocalist in the Baltimore-DC area, performing everything from sacred music to new music to folk and indie. They regularly appear with local ensembles including the Choir of Emmanuel Episcopal Church, Mind on Fire, Chantry, the Peabody NEXT Ensemble, and as a Vocal Fellow with the Baltimore Choral Arts Society. Former teachers include Michael Hersch, Felipe Lara, Phyllis Bryn-Julson, and Marian Hahn.



Composer, vocalist, and educator **Michael Rickelton** has been active in Baltimore's music community for the past 15 years. He performs regularly with organizations in Baltimore and the Washington, DC metro area, and has recorded as an ensemble singer and soloist with Naxos, Decca, and Gothic Records. An accomplished composer of music that "seizes the ear" (Gramophone Magazine), Michael has a powerful and critically acclaimed affinity for the voice. Composer Lori Laitman described Michael as having "a great and clear gift for writing for the voice," and BCAS Music Director Emeritus Tom Hall described his music as "engrossing, engaging, and consistently compelling." His music has received honors from ASCAP, American Composers Orchestra, The American Prize, Bluffton College, Gregg Smith and Syracuse University, Ithaca College, Lipscomb University, Meistersingers, Southeastern Composers' League, Pacific Chorale, and The Peabody Conservatory. His music has been featured in performances and readings by ensembles such as the Baltimore Symphony, Nashville Symphony, Pacific Chorale, and the Choir of the Washington National Cathedral.



**Stephen Harouff**, piano, has served as Music Director and Organist at Towson Presbyterian Church since 2014, leading choirs for children, youth, and adults, directing handbells, and leading congregational song from the organ and piano. He is deeply devoted to guiding musicians of varying skill levels towards authentic and unabashed expressions of faith. In addition to his time at TPC he also works as a conductor for Encore Creativity for Older Adults, a large community of choral singers age 55+. Stephen is a graduate of the Peabody Conservatory (organ) and West Virginia University (piano, music education) and has had some marvelous on-the-job training.



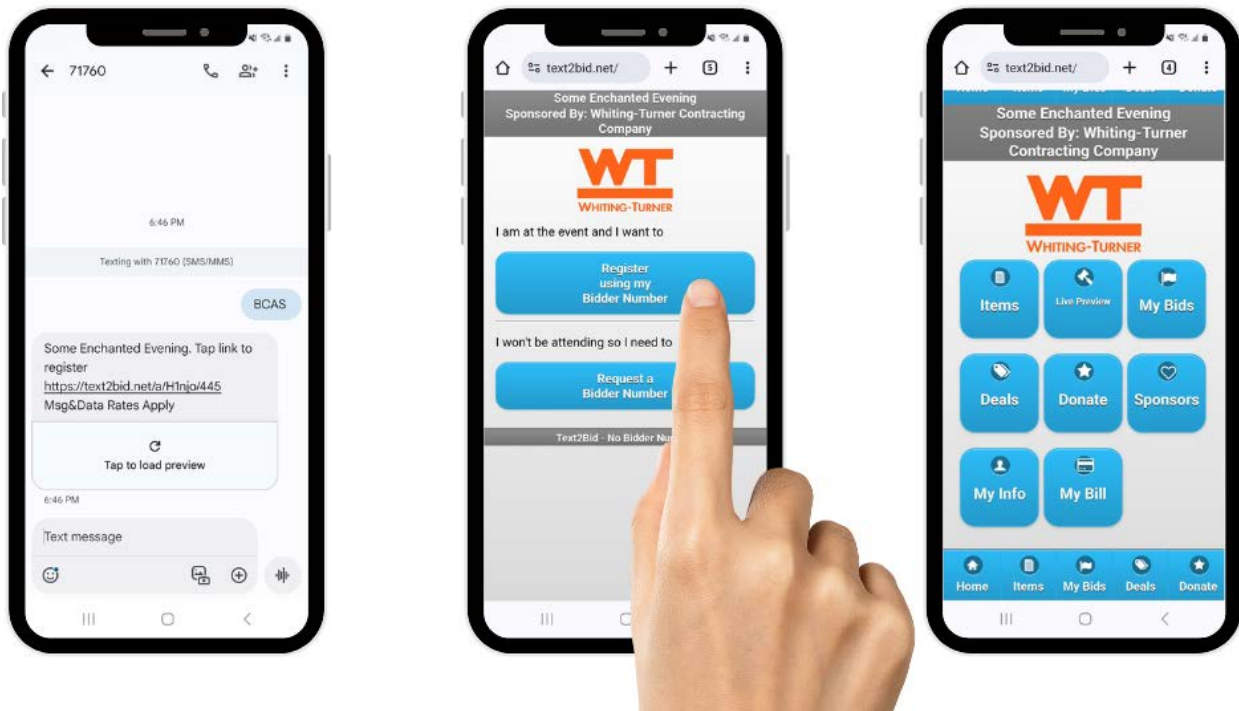

1. The online auction is from Wednesday, April 10 at 9 am ET to Friday, April 12 at 9 pm ET.
2. Participants can register by **texting code BCAS to 71760**. You will then be assigned a bidder number. Once you have a bidder number, you will be able to bid on auction items or donate toward Choral Arts' education and outreach programs.
3. Bidders are required to enter their credit card information and billing address during the online registration process, prior to bidding on items.
4. First bidders in the auction must observe at least the minimum bid. All subsequent bids are as shown.
5. If an item receives a bid within the last 5 minutes of the auction, bidding on that specific item will remain open until 60 seconds passes between subsequent bids.
6. Winning bidders will receive a text message after the auction closes with a list of the items they have won. Conversely, you may text WINNINGS to 71760 for your list of items won. You may easily pay for your auction items through the mobile bidding site.
7. **All sales are final.** Please read the specifications carefully for each item. There will be no refunds or exchanges.

## 6. South Texas Photography Excursion or Exotic Game Hunt at Las Lajas Game Ranch

Las Lajas Game Ranch is the only working cattle and game ranch in Zapata County, Texas, that has been in the same family since its original land grant by King Charles III of Spain in 1767. Our secluded 2,000-acre habitat is home to a variety of native species, including the iconic Texas whitetail deer, javelina, feral hogs, dove, quail, bobcats, coyotes, badgers, raccoons, rabbits and fluffy, ferocious yet adorable ground squirrels. It also features a 1400-acre high-fence preserve with managed populations of exotic game, including gold-medal Fallow Deer and Red Stags, Scimitar Oryx, Aoudad, Axis Deer, Blackbuck Antelope, Texas Dall Sheep, and Mouflon and Barbados Rams.

Both packages include a 4-day, 3-night stay for up to 4 people, personally hosted and guided by a direct descendant of Pedro Benavides (the original grantee) as well as of Cpt. Tomas Sanchez, founder of Laredo, Texas (one of the busiest land ports in the United States and a major gateway for trade between the U.S. and Mexico). Accommodations consist of up to 2 of our comfortable and spacious guest cabins, furnished in frontier-style decor, and include meals, private chef service and transportation between the Laredo International Airport and Las Lajas Game Ranch.

- **South Texas Photography Excursion.** The US/Mexico border along the Rio Grande is a topic of much debate lately. In addition to lodging and meals at Las Lajas Game Ranch-- with its breathtaking and unobstructed sunrises, sunsets, and night skies--experience the rich, historic multicultural Rio Grande Valley from the perspective of a South Texas insider. Enjoy unique opportunities to photograph the area's historic towns and rich biodiversity with personally guided day tours of Laredo, Zapata, the submerged town of Old Guerrero (if conditions allow) and Roma, and as well as our favorite spots for nature and landscape photography throughout Las Lajas Game Ranch. See how our commitment to conservation and responsible stewardship plays an important role in everything we do at Las Lajas Game Ranch. Value: \$3000
- **Exotic Game Hunt.** In addition to lodging and meals, the exotic game hunt includes a guided hunt for a trophy scimitar oryx (see description below). You may bring your own firearm or are welcome to use a Remington 30-06 from the host's personal collection. Hunters may choose from 45 blinds and stands from which to hunt in the early morning and late afternoon, or all day. Your guide will recommend blind locations based on the trophy you seek. Transportation to and from hunting areas will be provided by Las Lajas Game Ranch. Two-way radios are also available for safety and convenience, although cell phone signal is clear throughout the entire property. Hunters are responsible for securing all necessary licenses (assistance is available upon request). Value: \$6000

**What is a Scimitar Oryx?** The scimitar oryx is a North African species of antelope prized for its hide, horns and delicious meat. This majestic, graceful antelope can reach 4'6" in height at the shoulder and weigh up to 460 lbs. With long, curved horns that can grow to more than 4 feet in length, it is believed to have inspired the myth of the unicorn. The oryx once roamed North Africa and the Arabian Peninsula, but its population declined steadily over the last few thousand years until the 1980s, when overhunting and extended civil unrest caused the remaining wild populations to plummet. In 1991 the species was declared extinct in the wild, with the only surviving herds living in zoos and private reserves in Texas, the United Kingdom, Tunisia, Morocco, and the United Arab Emirates. However, through carefully managed breeding and reintroduction programs funded in part by hunting revenues, this cultural and ecological flagship species has emerged as a triumph of conservation. Efforts to reestablish the species in its native habitat have been so successful that in December 2023 the scimitar oryx was reclassified from "Extinct in the wild" to "Endangered" and shows a promising outlook for its continued recovery.

**Terms and Restrictions:** Valid through April 30, 2026. Airfare not included. For the hunting package, butchering and taxidermy services (including shipping of meat and trophies) are not included, but we work closely with an excellent butcher who will be glad to prepare game for consumption, can recommend several taxidermists, and can assist with obtaining estimates for shipping costs. With the exception of Whitetail Deer, game other than the scimitar oryx is available at the standard applicable rates. Photographers are responsible for bringing their own equipment, and any photography of Las Lajas Game Ranch that is intended for commercial purposes requires permission in advance and may be subject to additional conditions. All visitors to Las Lajas Game Ranch must adhere to all safety guidelines and Ranch rules and are required to sign a release and indemnity agreement prior to entry.

**Blackout Dates and Recommended Booking Dates:** Both packages are available for the months of February through September. Dates during the Archery, General, and Special-Late hunting seasons for Texas Whitetail Deer, which are set every year by the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department but generally run from October through mid-January, are not available because Las Lajas Game Ranch is booked for the Texas Whitetail season through 2029. However, because the scimitar oryx is not subject to seasonal hunting restrictions on private property and does not shed its horns, it is legal to hunt throughout the year with a general hunting license. Las Lajas Game Ranch recommends booking reservations for the months of February, March, April, or September, which are the most pleasant months of the year. From May to August, South Texas likes to set the thermostat to "lava" and people and animals avoid heat stroke by staying in their respective dwellings all day. Las Lajas also recommends booking as soon as possible! We proudly host many cherished guests from the United States and abroad, and reservations are booked on a first-come, first-served basis.

CoroLAB includes ongoing partnerships with the choral programs at Overlea High School and Baltimore City College. Choral Arts collaborates with high-school choral students in shared days of singing, competition preparation, and large-scale performances.

### Sing and Play Early Childhood Classes

In the fall of 2023, Choral Arts launched a new series of early childhood music classes in partnership with the Enoch Pratt Free Library: Sing and Play with Baltimore Choral Arts. Children experience singing, creative movement, and listening to musical stories that spark their imagination.
