## **Artists**

#### The Eric Byrd Trio

For over twenty years, **The Eric Byrd Trio (EBT)**, pianist/vocalist Eric Byrd,
bassist Bhagwan Khalsa, and
drummer Alphonso Young, Jr., have
traveled the world as enthusiastic
ambassadors of jazz. Rooted in swing
and bebop, The Trio also embraces
gospel and the blues as core
elements of their expansive
performance style. Their body of work



spans seven unique studio and live recordings on which they shine as a Trio and as collaborators with an expanded 8-piece ensemble they call The Eric Byrd Trio: Brother Ray Band, in tribute to The Genius of Soul icon Ray Charles. On each recording, they take a rigorous, modern approach to standards as well as original compositions, playing with great acuity within the broad and rich jazz tradition.

They also belong to the Maryland Performing Artist Touring Roster, which is a listing of Maryland-based performing artists who are experienced, organized and professional. Collectively, The Trio has played with trumpeters Wynton Marsalis, Terell Stafford and Randy Brecker, jazz guitarists Charlie Byrd and Mike Stern, jazz saxophonists Bob Berg, Buck Hill, David "Fathead" Newman, Tim Warfield and Cecil Payne, jazz pianists George Colligan and Kenny Drew, Jr., jazz saxophonists and flautists Sonny Fortune and Gary Thomas, be-bop jazz trumpeter, flugelhornist, flautist, and saxophonist Ira Sullivan, jazz steel pan player Othello Molineaux, jazz vibraphonist Warren Wolf, gospel harpist Jeff Majors, jazz vocalists Vanessa Rubin and Rebecca Parris, gospel vocalist Yolanda Adams, and Cuban American singer/songwriter Jon Secada.

Eric, Bhagwan, and Alphonso are educators with advanced degrees in Music History, African American Music, and Jazz Performance. They frequently give clinics on music history, jazz, and the relationship between the spirituals/gospel, blues, and jazz. Because of their immense knowledge of music, commitment to music education, and ability to teach diverse and international audiences, they have been sponsored by the United States Embassy as Kennedy Center/U.S. State Department Jazz Ambassadors touring South America, Central America, the Caribbean, Eastern & Western Europe, and the Middle East. The Trio has also delighted audiences across the globe at the historic Montreux Jazz Festival and in Bolivia, Chile, Colombia, Dubai, Estonia, Honduras, Italy, Peru, Scotland, and Trinidad and Tobago.

#### **Baltimore Choral Arts Vocal Fellows**

#### Julie Bosworth

Ever a chameleon, Julie Bosworth revels in versatile singing, seamlessly transitioning from "ethereal" to "the richest, most buttery tone" (Washington Classical Review). On the operatic stage, Julie has performed with the IN Series, American Opera Theater, Raylynmor Opera, Early Music Access Project, Opera AACC, and Peabody Opera Theater. Equally at home on the concert stage, Julie has sung extensively with American Bach Soloists, Tempesta di Mare, the Baltimore Symphony Orchestra, The Bach Choir of Bethlehem, Mountainside Baroque, the Handel Choir of Baltimore, True Concord Voices and Orchestra, Washington Bach Consort, Apollo's Fire, The Broken Consort, The Thirteen, The Peabody Consort, Hesperus, and Kinnara.

#### Carl Hengen

Carl Hengen wields an "heroic" Tenor voice well-suited to Bel Canto, Verismo, and any other genre that requires a strong vocal presence. Mr. Hengen has sung leading operatic roles such as Ruggero in Puccini's La Rondine, Nemorino in Donizetti's L'Elisir d'Amore, Aeneas in Purcell's Dido and Aeneas, The Snowman in Rorem's A Childhood Miracle and Donald in Douglas Moore's Gallantry. Additional credits include Gherardo in Puccini's Gianni Schicchi with the Oberlin-In-Italy program, and Benvolio in Gounod's Romeo et Juliette with Maryland Lyric Opera. He has also enjoyed performing with the Annapolis Opera chorus. Mr. Hengen teaches at the Baltimore School for the Arts, Lutherville Music School, and the Community College of Baltimore County, Essex Campus. He is also an accomplished Guitarist and Audio Engineer. Mr. Hengen holds a Graduate Performance Diploma from the Peabody Conservatory of Johns Hopkins University, among other degrees from Michigan State University (M.M.), the University of Maryland, College Park (B.M.), and The Community College of Baltimore County, Essex Campus (A.A.).

#### Patricia Hengen

Mezzo-soprano Patricia Hengen is a Baltimore native, who has performed in numerous venues in the Mid-Atlantic region. Earlier this year, she was seen in Annapolis Opera's production of Le Nozze di Figaro, and she represented the North Carolina district in the Metropolitan Opera's Laffont Competition. Recent roles include Aunt Dee/Drosselmeyer (The Nutcracker), Florinda (Into the Woods), Annina (La Traviata), Le Prince Charmant (Cendrillon), and Dreite Knabe (Die Zauberflote). Other productions include La Boheme, Carmen, Madama Butterfly, South Pacific, Hairspray: In Concert, and Tosca. She has appeared a soloist with Baltimore Choral Arts Society, the Baltimore Symphony, and the City Choir of Washington under the direction of Grammy awardwinning conductor, Robert Shafer. Ms. Hengen is a member of the Voice Faculty at the Baltimore School for the Arts, and in May, she will be the Alto Soloist with the Harford Chorus. Ms. Hengen is a graduate of Shenandoah Conservatory.

#### **Ross Tamaccio**

Since moving to Baltimore in 2016 from his hometown in Herndon, Virginia, Ross Tamaccio has enjoyed an emerging career as a solo and ensemble singer in the Maryland/DC area and throughout North America. He is a well-known soloist with Baltimore Choral Arts Society, Central Maryland Chorale, Bach in Baltimore, and Maryland Choral Society. As a sought-after ensemble singer, Ross performs with the Oregon Bach Festival Chorus, Bach Akademie Charlotte, the Santa Fe Desert Chorale, Conspirare, Cincinnati Vocal Arts Ensemble, the Thirteen Choir, Washington National Cathedral Choir, Baltimore Concert Opera, and has performed with the City of Birmingham Symphony Orchestra (England), Baltimore Symphony Orchestra, National Symphony Orchestra, Handel and Haydn Society, and Tafelmusik Baroque Chorus and Orchestra. #### Mara Yaffee

From ballads to Bach, storytelling is the centerpiece of Baltimore based soprano/multi-instrumentalist Mara Yaffee's interpretations. Mara was a 2022 Fellow for NYC Early Music Ensemble ARTEK's Madrigal Madness, is a current Vocal Fellow for the Baltimore Choral Arts Society, and recently portrayed Euridyce in *The Nightsong of Orpheus* with IN Series Opera. Mara is very excited to be joining the Boston Early Music Festival this Spring as a Young Artist. As a songwriter and singer of traditional folk and popular music of the English language, Mara uses guitar, autoharp, mountain dulcimer, and other instruments to accompany herself. Mara holds her BFA in Vocal Performance from Carnegie Mellon University and her MM in Historical Performance Voice from Peabody Conservatory.

#### Jordan Prescott, pianist

Hailed by *The Baltimore Sun* as a "rising organ star," Jordan Prescott has established himself as one of the leading organists, conductors, and scholars of his generation. As a solo recitalist, Jordan performs extensively across the United States including appearances at Trinity Church (Boston), West Point Military Academy Cadet Chapel, Princeton University Chapel, Washington National Cathedral (Washington, D.C.), Grace Cathedral (San Francisco), St. Thomas Fifth Avenue, and the Cathedral of St. John the Divine (New York City). As an ensemble musician, Jordan has appeared under the batons of Marin Alsop, Nicolas McGegan, and Joseph Young. Jordan earned first prize in the 16th International Organ Competition at West Chester University and was named one of *Diapason* magazine's '20 Under 30' in 2019. Jordan's research has been published in *The American Organist* and *Tracker* magazines and he regularly presents conference workshops, guest lectures, and masterclasses.
